

LENT 4: Wednesday, March 11 – Tuesday, March 17

Over seven days, complete one zine page per day by following the instructions below (categorized by image).

FIGURES

- Slowly draw connecting lines between words, stringing together a web of new phrases of any length. It may be helpful to separate phrases by using different colored pens or pencils.

LINED PAPERS

- Each line has a predetermined first or last word. Write poetic lines incorporating the words, leaving the given words in their respective spots. Try to craft complete poems.

WAVES

- Haikus are 3-lined poems that follow a specific syllabic count. The first line contains **five** syllables, the second line has **seven**, and the third line has **five**.
- From magazines, newspapers, or whatever text scraps you have on hand, find and cut out three lines containing the proper amount of syllables (5-7-5) and paste them into your zine to craft a haiku.
- Try to find lines in their entirety rather than cutting and pasting individual words.

DOTS

- Find another person and play a game of Dots and Boxes. If you do not know how to play, find a person who does.
